

Pharmacy Council of New Zealand (Fees) Notice 2017

Pursuant to sections 130-133 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003, the following notice is given.

This notice is effective from **24 February 2017** and revokes and replaces all previous Pharmacy Council of New Zealand fees notices.

Notice

1. Title and commencement—This notice may be cited as the Pharmacy Council of New Zealand (Fees) Notice 2017 and shall come into force on **24 February 2017**.

2. Fees—The Pharmacy Council of New Zealand sets the following fees, payable to the Council, specified in the attached Schedule.
